# OPEN CUPBOARD PANTRY (COP)

The COP is an emergency food source for residents of Temple, Wilton, Lyndeborough and Greenfield. It was founded in 1996 and is currently occupying space in the Wilton Falls Building across from the Police Station. The COP is staffed solely by volunteers.

All are welcome, no one in an emergency situation has ever been turned away. People coming to the COP have different needs. Some come once a year, some once a month and some come every two weeks. Families who come regularly must meet state income guidelines.

The COP is totally supported through donations from generous individuals and organizations in the towns served. All donations are tax deductible.
